Understand why fostering camaraderie, collaboration and inclusion are key to cultural transformation.

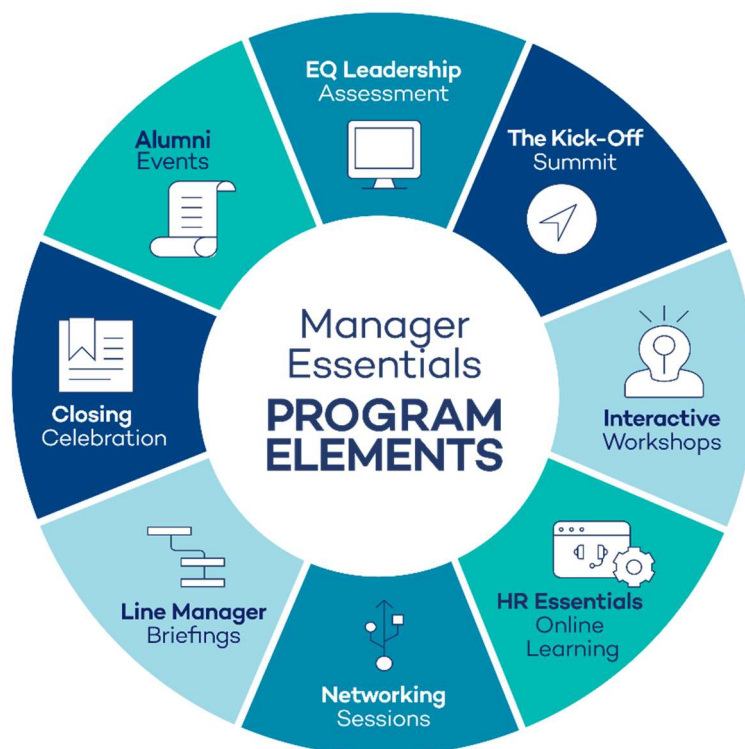
