(2) The Port Adelaide Maritime Corporation was dissolved with effect from 1 September 2007. The operations of the Corporation have been assumed by the new Administrative Unit, Defence SA.

(3) Includes employees transferred from Domiciliary Care SA 1 July 2007, formerly reported under Health Units.

(4) Excludes Bio Innovations SA, these employees are reported separately under Other Public Sector. For reporting purposes excludes TAFE84 employees as they do not meet the definition of a SA Public Sector employee.

(5) Includes Police Security and Police Band.

(6) Excludes the Office for Volunteers transferred to Attorney-General's Department January 2007. Excludes SA Local Government Grants Commission, who are reported separately from 2007 under Other Public Sector.

(7) Includes Super SA and SAFA. Excludes Electorate Offices. These employees are reported separately under Other Public Sector. Includes employees of Shared Services SA, created on 15 October 2007.

- (10) The number and type of functions managed determines the amount of casual work available in each pay period. The figure provided is only representative of this organisation's workforce as at June 2008 and should not be considered an accurate reflection of the overall workforce for the 2007-2008 period. The Adelaide Convention Centre (ACC) did not supply detailed employee data for June 2008. Where possible, figures from the ACC Annual Report have been used.
- (11) Excludes persons employed under Special Acts and the Judicial Administration Act. These employees, including five statutory appointments, are reported separately from 1999 under 'Judiciary'.
- (12) Includes all persons employed under the Personal Assistants to the Members of the Parliament Enterprise Agreement.
- (13) These figures represent the total workforce of the Health Units incorporated under the SA Health Commission Act and the Institute of Medical and Veterinary Science Act. Excludes Domiciliary Care SA employees transferred to Department for Families and Communities 1 July 2007. Includes employees associated with transfer of management of Modbury Hospital back to the government of South Australia from 1 July 2007.
- (14) Does not include persons employed under Special Acts and the Judicial Administration Act who work in the Industrial Court System. Although Judicial Officers are not public sector employees, they are included in this report because they receive remuneration from the State of South Australia according to decisions made by the Remuneration Tribunal.
