(3) The number and type of functions managed determines the amount of casual work available in each pay period. The figure provided is only representative of this organisation's workforce as at June 2008 and should not be considered an accurate reflection of the overall workforce for the 2007-2008 period.

(4) Excludes persons employed under Special Acts and the Judicial Administration Act. These employees, including five statutory appointments, reported separately as of 2007 under 'Judiciary'.

(5) Includes all persons employed under the Personal Assistants to the Members of the Parliament Enterprise Agreement.

(6) These figures represent the total workforce of the Health Units incorporated under the SA Health Commission Act and the Institute of Medical and Veterinary Science Act. Excludes Domiciliary Care SA employees transferred to Department for Families and Communities 1 July 2007. Includes employees associated with transfer of management of Modbury Hospital back to the government of South Australia from 1 July 2007.

(7) Does not include persons employed under Special Acts and the Judicial Administration Act who work in the Industrial Court System. Although Judicial Officers are not public sector employees, they are included in this report because they receive remuneration from the State of South Australia according to decisions made by the Remuneration Tribunal.
