- (2) Excludes a number of employees transferred to Shared Services SA in the Department of Treasury and Finance between 1 July 2008 and 30 June 2009.
- (3) The State Electoral Office was renamed the Electoral Commission of South Australia in January 2009.
- (4) Excludes Bio Innovations SA, these employees are reported separately under Other Public Sector organisations. For reporting purposes excludes TAFE84 employees as they do not meet the definition of a SA Public Sector employee.
- (5) Established as a new Administrative Unit in November 2008. Includes employees in Planning SA, the Office for State/Local Government Relations and the Office for the Southern Suburbs, transferred from the Department of Primary Industries and Resources of South Australia. Although Judicial Officers are not public sector employees, they are included in this report because they receive remuneration from the State of South Australia according to decisions made by the Remuneration Tribunal.
